# What is included in the program?

## Professional Development Skills (PD) Training

- 8 days of Professional Development Skills covering 16 topics (1/2 day per topic)
- Focusing on Leadership, Teambuilding, Customer Service, and Communications

## Electric Utility Operational Skills (EU) Training

- 2 days of EU Classroom Sessions covering 3 topics
- Serve as a judge at an Annual Lineworkers Rodeo. Two opportunities to complete during the program window
- Participate as a “coach” at two operational field training sessions. 2020 Sessions are listed below and include: Climbing Level 1, Lineman Power School, etc.
- Participate in one operational field training session, e.g. Capacitor 101 or Substation Awareness

- Participants are expected to attend all Professional Development classroom sessions
- Participants must meet all four EU Operational Skills requirements listed above to complete the program
